

Anderson/Hauglund Memorial HorsePlex Annual Membership

Dear Past or Potential HorsePlex Member:

Thank you for your support of the HorsePlex on the Stevens County Fairgrounds in Morris.

The combination to the building will be changed as we begin the new annual membership program year. If you would like to use the HorsePlex indoor riding arena, please fill out an updated membership form and return it along with your membership fee (**checks made payable to Stevens County Fair**) to Stevens County Fair Board, PO Box 622, Morris MN 56267. All families that use the HorsePlex must complete the form below. When you return the form and payment (see form for details), you will be given the new code and allowed access until the end of September 2024. **Please include your email on the form; codes and arena updates will only be emailed.**

In order to cover the cost of the electric bill and to be able to afford more maintenance of the footing and grounds, we will be charging the following membership fees for use of the building:

- Enrolled Stevens County 4-H members/volunteers – no charge (must still return signed waiver) (Note: to be considered enrolled, your current 4-H Online status must be “approved.”)
- Community Families – \$100/year use fee
- For Open Shows or Non-4-H Events please contact the Fair Board for use of the outdoor arena/whole facility.
- No charge for individual use of the outdoor arena; however, you are still riding at your own risk.

Here are the basic rules for using the HorsePlex:

- NO parking trailers or taking horses on the west side of the building or in the area from the tar path to Co. Rd. 22. (Please park between the indoor and outdoor arena or to the east of the outdoor arena.)
- Before leaving the HorsePlex, clean up after you and your horse. Make sure to close and lock all doors, and shut off electrical. If you are found not to have cleaned up manure, supplies, pens, etc., your membership will be revoked.
- No use of tobacco or alcohol products in the indoor or outdoor arena.
- From October 1 - May 1, the large garage doors will be locked and not available for use. Only the regular walk through door will be able to be opened with a code (this is due to repeated damage to the large doors due to ice and force).
- **Do not share the HorsePlex facility code with anyone.** Your membership only covers your immediate family; do not give the code or invite non-members to ride in the HorsePlex. If you are found to be sharing your membership and code, your membership will be revoked without a refund.

Facility has camera surveillance.

HorsePlex Warnings

Livestock activities pose inherent risks. These dangers or conditions are an integral part of livestock activities, and they include but are not limited to...

1. The propensity of livestock to behave in ways that may result in death or injury to persons on or around them, such as kicking, biting or bucking;
2. The unpredictability of livestock's reaction to things like sound, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
3. Natural hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions; or
4. Collisions with other livestock or objects.

The Stevens County Agricultural Society (Fair Board) and persons donating services, livestock, facilities, or equipment for use, are immune from liability to participants in livestock activities resulting from these inherent risks pursuant to Minn. Stat. & 694a.12. Those who participate do so at their own risk and should take all necessary precautions to ensure their own safety and the safety of others.

I agree to the following terms as a member of the HorsePlex:

- Before leaving the HorsePlex, clean up after you and your horse. Make sure to close and lock all doors, and shut off electrical. If you are found not to have cleaned up manure, supplies, pens, etc., your membership will be revoked.
- No use of tobacco or alcohol products in the indoor or outdoor arena.

I have read and understand the use of the grounds and all the risks involved. The code will be good from October 1 each year; this is an annual membership and will need to be renewed each year. You will receive an email with the code once we receive your completed form and payment.
